

Dear Parents or Guardians,

Johannesburg-Lewiston Area Schools (JLAS) is doing all we can to keep our students safe and healthy. Therefore, during this emergency school closure, JLAS plans to provide free meals through the USDA Summer Food Service Program Unanticipated School Closure. Meals are available to kids and teens ages 18 and younger. Breakfast and lunch foods for 5 days will be broken up between two pick-up days.

Free Meal Program Details:

- Meals are FREE to children and teens ages 18 and younger, even if they are not students at JLAS.
- Free meals will help families save money and stretch their already tight food budgets
- Food served is healthy and follows USDA nutrition guidelines. Every attempt is being made to offer a variety of food options, but there are currently limitations in food availability.
- Children do not need to be present. A parent or guardian can pick up the meal and bring it home to them.
- One person can pick up meals for multiple families.
- **Please let us know how many meals you plan to pick up, if you haven't already. We cannot "hold" meals for families, even if they call in. An accurate estimate ensures that all kids who need a meal will get one.**
- No application or proof of income needed. Just tell us how many children when you pick up the meals.
- Current program will end April 3, 2020. New information will be announced after that date.

Lewiston from 11-12 at the playground entrance bus loop

Johannesburg High School from 3-4 near the entrance to the gymnasium
